**S**ri Bhagawan Mahaveer Jain College of Engineering (SBMJCE) has successfully placed more than 70 per cent of its students in various companies this academic year. It is hopeful of making it cent per cent in the coming days as the placement session is still underway.

Till now, around 20 companies had come to the campus for their recruitment initiatives and among them, Mahendra Satyam has hired the most number of students. The alumni of the college took great interest in the process and have helped the college by bringing one company—Technotree—for the placement session.

Readiminds, Firepro Systems, EMC2, Synopsys, Goldman Sachs, Accenture, Triumph Software, Wrench Solutions, Jindal Steel Works, Bristlecone, XYSYS Technologies are some of the companies that have already completed their recruitment process in the campus.

"We have provided aptitude and soft skills training through the placement cell of the college for all the students before they attended the interview. It was a one-

week programme where the students were trained in all required areas. Mock interviews, group discussions and other soft-skill training boosted their confidence while going through the placement process," says Dr Easwaran, the Placement Director of the Institute. Nitish S, an Information Science student, has been taken in by Accenture for a lucrative package of Rs 3.20 lakh per annum. Nitish, who has bagged the excellence award in the college this year for his academic and cultural activities, is looking forward to his new job at Accenture and is dreaming about his future. "I was up-to-date with my academics and improved my aptitude skills before attending the interview. Our college had arranged coaching classes and conducted mock interviews which helped us to smarten up communication skills and to refocus on the basics of Information Science," says Nitish.
