

Eligibility Criteria for the programmes under Jain University

Undergraduate Programmes

1. BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (B.Com)

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a pass in the 10+2 examination or equivalent from any recognized Central or State Board. A course recognized as equivalent thereto by the University, desirably with the relevant or related subjects as one of the subjects of study.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally through merit, based on performance in the qualifying exam. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test in addition, there to.

2. BACHELOR OF MEDIA STUDIES (BMS)

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a pass in the 10+2 examination or equivalent from any recognized Central or State Board. A course recognized as equivalent thereto by the University, desirably with the relevant or related subjects as one of the subjects of study.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally through merit, based on performance in the qualifying exam. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test in addition, there to.

3. BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA)

4. BACHELOR OF BUSINESS MANAGEMENT (B.B.M)

A course recognized as equivalent thereto by the University, desirably with the relevant or related subjects as one of the subjects of study.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally through merit, based on performance in the qualifying exam. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test in addition, there to.

5. BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS (BCA)

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a pass in the 10+2 examination or equivalent from any recognized Central or State Board. A course recognized as equivalent thereto by the University, desirably with the relevant or related subjects as one of the subjects of study.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally through merit, based on performance in the qualifying exam. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test in addition, there to.

6. BACHELOR OF INTERIOR DESIGN (BID)

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a pass in the 10+2 examination or equivalent from any recognized Central or State Board. A course recognized as equivalent thereto by the University, desirably with the relevant or related subjects as one of the subjects of study.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally through merit, based on performance in the qualifying exam. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test in addition, there to.

8. BACHELOR OF ENGINEERING (B.E.) [Computer Science / Electronics & Communication / Information Science / Electrical & Electronics / Mechanical / Civil/ Aerospace]

1. A Candidate should have passed (10+2) course or equivalent course recognized by state or central board and secured minimum marks as prescribed by State Government for the admission year 2009-10.
2. The method of selection for the course shall be normally through merit, based on performance in the qualifying exam. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test in addition, there to.

Postgraduate Programmes

9. MASTER OF COMMERCE (M.COM)

1. The Minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
2. The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

10. MS MASS COMMUNICATION

1. The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
2. The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

11. MASTER OF SCIENCE BIOCHEMISTRY (M.Sc. BC)

1. The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
2. The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

12. MASTER OF SCIENCE BIOTECHNOLOGY (M.Sc. BT)

1. The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
2. The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

13. MASTER OF SCIENCE MICROBIOLOGY (M.Sc. MB)

1. The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
2. The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

14. MASTER OF SCIENCE PHYSICS (M.Sc. Physics) [Materials Science / Electronics]

1. The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
2. The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

15. MASTER OF SCIENCE PSYCHOLOGY (M.Sc. Psychology) [Clinical / Counselling / Industry Psychology]

1. The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
2. The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

16. MASTER OF ARTS HINDI

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.

- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

17. MASTER OF ARTS SANSKRIT

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

18. MASTER OF ARTS KANNADA

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

19. MASTER OF ARTS ENGLISH

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

20. MASTER OF ARTS ECONOMICS

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

21. MASTER OF ARTS CLASSICAL MUSIC

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

22. MASTER OF ARTS CLASSICAL DANCE

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a degree from recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or in the relative / respective subject.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall normally be by means of a Personal Interview. However, for some programmes, the admission might also be by means of an entrance test.

23. MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA)

- 1 The minimum qualification required to be eligible for admission is a minimum of 50% aggregate in the Graduate / Degree examination of a recognized University, desirably with relevant or related subject as one of the subjects of study.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall be normally by means of a Group Discussion and Personal Interview. Institutions may decide to conduct additional test to select candidates. The shortlist of candidates to be called for GD/ PI shall be prepared based on the score obtained by them in the Management Aptitude Test conducted by the All India Management Association. The minimum acceptable score is 500 out of 800 or 50th percentile.

24. MASTER OF COMPUTER APPLICATION (MCA)

- 1 A Candidate should have passed degree (10+2+3) course or equivalent course recognized by state or Central board and secured minimum marks of 50% as prescribed by State Government for the admission year 2009-10. However he/she shall have studied Mathematics / Business mathematics / Statistics / Business Statistics / Mathematics and Statistics / Computer Programming. Computer Science/ Computer Applications either at Degree level or at 10+2 level securing 50% of marks.
- 2 The method of selection for the course shall be normally through merit, based on performance in the qualifying exam. In addition the student must have qualified in a national level entrance test like PG CET or KMAT or CAT or Test conducted by Jain University.

25. MASTER OF TECHNOLOGY (M.Tech) [Aerospace / Computer Science / Mechanical / Electronics & Communication / Energy Engineering]

- 1 Categories of student status: The following are the three categories of student status in the M.Tech degree Programme:
 - (a) Full-time student qualified through GATE / PG (CET)
 - (b) Full-time sponsored student from industry or other Organizations including Educational Institutions
 - (c) Sponsored faculty of Jain University
- 2 The criteria for selection/ admission for full-time students on GATE / PG (CET) qualified will include the GATE/ PG (CET) score, performance in the qualifying examination. The shortlisted candidates will be called for an Entrance Test conducted by the University. The final selection will be based on the Entrance Test and interview. However, the admission to other categories will be based on performance in qualifying examination, interview and guidelines issued by the Academic Council of the Jain University from time to time.
- 3 Admission to a M. Tech Programme shall be open to candidates who passed the prescribed qualifying degree examination with not less than 50% marks in the aggregate (taking into account the marks scored in all the subjects of all the University examinations conducted during the entire prescribed period for the programme). The Sc/ST category of candidates will require at least 45%.

26. MASTER OF PHILOSOPHY (M.Phil) [Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences / Commerce and Management / Sciences]

Master Degree with not less than 55% of marks in the relevant or related subjects of this University or of any other University recognized by JAIN University as equivalent thereto. Candidates who are qualified for CA of ACS or ICWA with basic degree are also eligible to register for M.Phil in this category. Candidates who have qualified for Masters Degree prior to 19-09-1991, with not less than 50% of the marks are also eligible to register for M.Phil programme in the University. SC/ ST candidates are given 5% exemption from the prescribed minimum marks.

27. DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (Ph.D) [Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences / Commerce and Management/ Science/ Engineering Science]

Master Degree with not less than 55% of marks in the relevant or related subjects of this University or of any other University recognized by JAIN University as equivalent thereto. Candidates who are qualified for CA of ACS or ICWA with basic degree are also eligible to register for Ph.D in this category. Candidates who have qualified for Masters Degree prior to 19-09-1991, with not less than 50% of the marks are also eligible to register for M.Phil programme in the University. SC/ ST candidates are given 5% exemption from the prescribed minimum marks.
