**'Saving Hindi' conference**

A language spoken by 437 million people is on the verge of losing its identity at its own place – Hindi is taking a backseat in India. That was the consensus at a 2-day conference on the language. Organized by the faculty of art, humanitarian and social science of Jain University on Wednesday, literary scholar Himanshu Joshi said: "It's important for us to educate children and make them aware about how our rich history has many things in common with the language."
