SJASC lose to Jain varsity

Bangalore: St Joseph's Arts & Science College lost to Jain University 2-3 in the hockey event of the Aaspire VIE 2011 All-India inter-college tournament on Thursday. In another match, DB Jain College scored a thumping win over Jain University, Kanakapura beating them with a margin of eight goals.

In the bowling event being held at Star City, Prajwal SD of SBM Jain College bounced back from a slow start to take the lead in the first round of the boys' category. Prajwal, who scored a relatively low 159 in the first game, made strong comeback in the second game, hitting five strikes in a row to score 225, finishing with an average of 192 and taking the top spot in the leaderboard thus far. Following him closely is Rajeev Kaushik of Dayanand Sagar College who scored an average of 188.5 over two games.

Leading the girls' category thus far is Ashwini Jaisimha, also of SBM Jain College, who scored a total pin-fall of 231 and an average of 115.5 in her first round entry of two games.
