## Ekalavya awards presented to State's achievers

BENGALURU, DHNS: Minister for Youth Empowerment and Sports, Pramod Madhwaraj announced government employment for players bringing the country laurels on the international stage during the presentation of Ekalavya Awards to State athletes here on Wednesday.

Speaking prior to the felicitation, the Minister said: "Olympic medallists will be given Group A level appointments in the State Government while medallists from CWG and Asian Games will be given Group 'B'level jobs."

"Under me, this Guru Nanak Bhavan premises was retrieved. When the file to extend the lease came to me, we decided to get this Rs 300-crore worth property back and we achieved it," he added.
