on Saturday. Samarath scored an unbeaten 123 runs from 151 balls that included seven boundaries. Winning the toss, Jain skipper Kaunain Abbas elected to bat, on a grassy wicket. The first wicket fell early as opener Gau-rav Goel was caught behind off Prateek Dahbolkar for seven. Other opener Shashindra (38), with Liyan Khan made a 65 run partnership, before giving an easy catch at mid-on off leftarm spinner Vinit Dulain. Liyan made 46 before trapped

in front of the wicket by Dulian. Kaunain hit an elegant half-century, while Nihal Ullal 26 and shared a 69-run partnership with Samarth for the seventh wicket.
