Mumbai to meet Jain

MANIPAL: A 67-run last-wicket partnership between Sagar Goriwal and Dabholkar Prateek proved the turning point in University of Mumbai's 60-run victory over Jamia Millia Islamia in the semifinals of the all-India inter-university cricket tournament here on Thursday.

In the final to be played this weekend, Mumbai will take on Jain (Bangalore) which registered a comfortable win over Jiwaji.

Goriwal and Prateek chanced their arms to push Mumbai to a respectable 217. Jamia stuttered to 80 for four and once Surinder Dahiya was dismissed with the score at 115, it was curtains for the North Zone runner-up.

For Mumbai, left-arm spinner Vinit Dhulad used his flight to prise out four batsmen, including Dahiya.
