

Jagadeesh bags four as Jain varsity make final

Left-arm spinner Suchit Jagadeesh took four wickets as Jain University, Bangalore (Southern Champs) defeated Mumbai University (Western Wolves) by six runs in a low-scoring semifinal in the Toyota University Cricket Championship in Mumbai on Friday. They now face Jamia University, Delhi in the final on Sunday. Bangalore elected to bat first but some great bowling by Mumbai restricted them to just 145/6 in the stipulated 20 overs. Gourav Goel was the top-scorer for Jain, making 38 from 42 balls. Mumbai's batting line-up failed to deliver with Kevin D'Almeida managing just 21 runs.
