Meenakshi makes a splash

Jain University swimmers Meenakshi and Poorva V.K.R Shetye dominated the proceedings on the second day of the All-India inter-university aquatic championships held at the Jain International Residential School here on Monday.

Meenakshi claimed gold medal in the 200 metres freestyle event clocking 2:15:09 seconds before returning to the pool to take home the yellow metal in the 400 metres medley.

She touched pad in 5:21:13 seconds to rewrite the previous record of 5:25:80 seconds held by Pooja Alva of VTU.

Meanwhile, fellow Jain University student Poorva continued her impressive form as she claimed the top prize in 50 metres breast stroke, with a time of 36:41 seconds, ahead of Priyanka (36:81s) from Delhi University and Divya Guruswamy

(38:14s) from VTU.

Poorva also bagged silver in 400M medley, to complete a one-two for Jain University, with a timing of 5:41:35 seconds and a bronze in 800M freestyle where she stopped the clock at 10:24:12 seconds.
