Arvind, Meenakshi on song on penultimate day

VTU, Blegaum, and Meenakshi VKR of host's Jain University continued to sparkle as the duo went on to add more medals to their personal tally in the Inter-University Aquatic Cham-pionship here on Wednesday.

Arvind, who has represented India at the Youth Asian Games, won the men's 200M individual medley in dominant fashion as he finished in 2:11.88, a comfortable five seconds ahead of Delhi University's Pulkit, who won the silver in 2:16.23.

Puniab University's Jashandeep Singh won the bronze af-

ter clocking 2:16.48. The 100M backstroke also saw VTU's lead act win the race

swimmer won the yellow metal in 59.75 seconds with Anna University's Abbasuddin K finishing second in 1:03.21 and Jain's Rakshith Shetty complet-

ing the podium in 1:04.35. In the women's section, local favourite Meenakshi continued her dominance as she pocketed gold in the 200M individual medley and the 100M backstroke, which also saw her break a three-year-old meet record.

Meenakshi won the medley in facile manner, touching the pad in 2:31.55, a solid nine seconds ahead of her team-mate Poorva Shetye (2:40.40).
