

Workshop on Cyber Forensics and Ethical Hacking

Two day workshop on “**Cyber Forensics and Ethical Hacking**” was organized at School of Graduate Studies, J C Road Campus on 18 and 19 February 2014. The workshop was organized as a collaborative endeavor of the Department of Bachelor of Computer Application (**BCA**) and Department of Information Security Management Services (**ISMS**).
