

## FREEDOM OF ART

Department of Animation, Jain University celebrated Independence Day through '**Freedom of Art**'. To execute the theme, the students of Animation department made a 20x20 feet art installation. The circle had a huge map of India which was decorated with different forms of artwork representing the cultural heritage of India. The rivers and green pastures were painted; the miniature models of some of the monuments of India were made with paper and thermocol. The students also made origami lotuses for the floor art. A huge Ashoka Pillar made with thermocol and painted in gold was placed at the middle of the map. Artworks made using paper quilling were also displayed along with pictures of 3D models made by the students.

Besides celebrating Independence Day, through this activity animation students got a hands-on experience to create different monument models and an opportunity to understand the architectural work behind them. This experience helps them to create such structures in the digital format and imbibe the habit of Research in their future works.

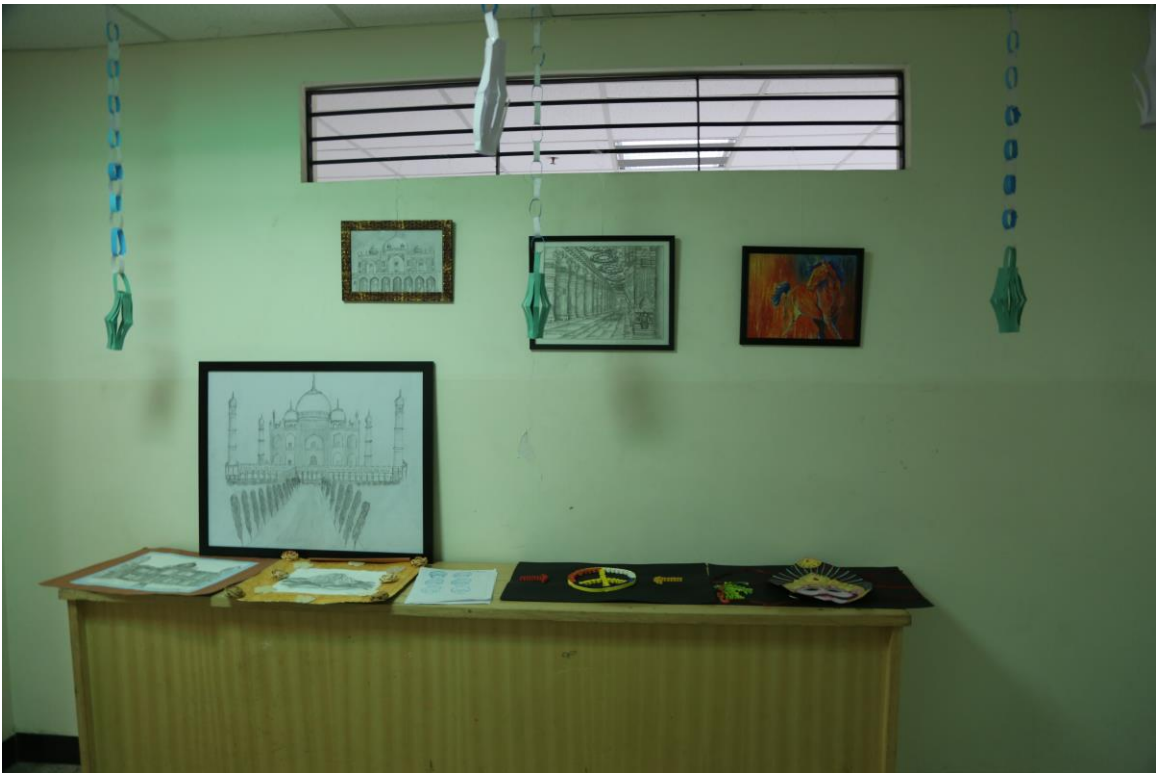
