

Two week residential summer workshop on 'Analyzing Quantitative Data on Indian Politics'

Jain University in collaboration with Lokniti-CSDS organizes a two week residential **Summer Workshop on 'Analyzing Quantitative Data on Indian Politics'** from Monday, **7 July 2014** to Friday, **18 July 2014** at Bangalore.

This is the fifth Annual Summer School on Quantitative Techniques in Political Science Research being organized by Jain University. Some of the leading scholars working on empirical methods in Political Science have been involved in designing this summer school. In this Summer School there will be a special emphasis on making sense of quantitative data on Indian politics. The workshop will bring together a group of social scientists with the aim of providing them an opportunity to improve their skills in quantitative analysis. 25 participants drawn from across the South Asian region have been selected for the course.
