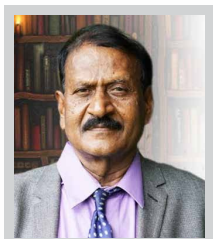
Objectives of the Programme

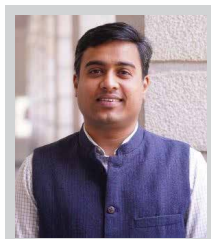
