November 26 is celebrated in India as the Constitution Day (Law Day) and December 10 as the International Human Rights Day globally. In commemoration of both these events, the School of Law and Governance, Jain University is organizing an essay competition for the students of PUC / +1 & +2 students, all over India.

<b>Word limit:</b>	Not more than 5000 words, excluding an abstract which shall not be more than 200 words.
<b>Medium of Writing:</b>	English
<b>Format:</b>	MS Word Document
<b>Submission:</b>	The completed essay shall be submitted on or before <b>December 31, 2017</b> to the Law School at: <b><u><a href="mailto:info.slg@jainuniversity.ac.in">info.slg@jainuniversity.ac.in</a></u></b> ,
<b>Mode of Evaluation:</b>	Blind evaluation
<b>Announcement of Result:</b>	Result will be published on the Jain University Website and with due intimation to the institution. Date will be announced later

### **Conditions**

- The competition is open only to students of the PUC / +1 & +2 students in India.
- Only one entry is permitted from each participant.
- Since this is a competition based on individual performance, any number of entries can be made from the same institution.
- The participating students should send (1) a proof of their study (school id / letter or certificate from the head of the Institution), (2) a declaration to the effect that the submitted work is the participants own work and not being submitted for any publication in any format anywhere else along with **the essay in a single mail** as attachments.
- Non attachment of the proof of study will lead to the rejection of the entry.
- The participants shall specify their full name, class in which they are pursuing the study, name of the Institution in which they are studying with complete address and contact details of the Institution.
- No correspondence from the participant will be entertained by the organizers. Result will be published in JU Website and communicated to the Institution.
- Each entry will be subjected to strict plagiarism test. If the similarity is more than 15%, the entry will be rejected.
- There shall be no registration fee for the competition.
- Any discrepancy and malpractice found at any time during or after competition will result in disqualification.

### ***Every final submission email shall contain:***

1. Abstract in 200 words
2. Essay in not more than 5000 words
3. Name of the participant and proof of study
4. Address and contact details of the Institution
5. Self-declaration that the submitted essay is an original work of the participant and not published elsewhere.

<b>1<sup>st</sup> Prize:</b>	<b>Rs. 10,000/-</b>
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Prize:</b>	<b>Rs. 7,000/-</b>
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Prize:</b>	<b>Rs. 5,000/-</b>

Prize winners will also receive Merit Certificates and authors of all valid submissions will be eligible for Participation Certificates.
