'INS Vikrant' is the first aircraft carrier used by the Indian government in 1971 Indo-Pak war. The 22-foot replica of the warship not only rekindles wartime memories but also establishes the fact that patriotism is still alive in the minds of millennials.

The concept of the warship model is developed by the Animation Department of Jain University and it took one month to com-

plete the structure.

About this initiative, Dinesh Damodaran, HoD of Animation Department, said, "Students of the department have come together to build this model to showcase the significance of this warship. Every year, we come up with some new initiatives to observe Independence Day in our university." The model will be on display till August 23.
