Jain University emerge champs

Jain University College emerged champions in the KSCA inter-collegiate tournament with a 82-run victory over Presidency College.

Jain made 287/8 in 50 overs with Dinesh Borwankar (88) and Girija Shankar (73) guiding them. In reply, Presidency were bowled out for 205 in 48.2 overs with only Abhishek Reddy (65), putting up a fight. For the winners, Daniel Sequeira picked up 4-40.

superb all-round show (105 & 4-36) and D. Nischal top-scored with 152 to guide KSCA XI to a six-wicket win over Singapore XI at the JIIRS ground on Friday.

Batting first, the visitors put up a challenging 298/8

in 50 overs on the back of Kshitij Shinde 106 and Chetan Suryawanshi's 96. But KSCA XI, reached the target with two balls to spare after Raghavendra had laid the platform with a brisk 105 (101 balls, 7x4, 2x6) and Nischal's 152 (165

balls, 14x4, 1x6).
