## Jain Uty emerge champs

Jain University Bangalore were crowned the all-India inter-zonal University champions with a resounding 82-run win over Bombay University in the final at the Manipal University ground here on Sunday.

Chasing 336 for an unlikely win, Bombay were bundled out for 253 in 78.3 overs. The only time

Bombay seemed to be clawing to an advantage was when Pankaj Jaiswal and Shashank Singh came together for the sixth wicket. From 155 for five, they took the score to 222 when Shashank was dismissed by Samarth for 32. Bombay had very little fight left in them after the Shashank dismissal.

Earlier, Mumbai lost two quick wickets at the start, both picked by medium

pacers C.A. Karthik. But it did not rattle their confidence as a 50-run partnership for the third wicket between Jaideep Pardesi and Kevin Almeida steadied the innings. Kevin was trapped leg before by off-spinner Daniel Sequeira for 19 and Jaideep too was lured in front of the wicket by Shashindra, for a well-made 53. Thereafter, the Jain

bowlers kept things tight Jaiswal and Shashank revived Bombay's hopes. Jaiswal later was bowled for 72 by Samarth. Samarth of Jain was declared man of the match and series as well.
