JAIN DOWN ALIGARH TO ENTER QUARTERS

South Zone runners-up Jain University, Bangalore prevailed over North Zone winners, Aligarh Muslim University by three wickets in their quarterfinal of the All-India inter-zonal University cricket here on Tuesday. After restricting Aligarh to 183/9 in the truncated 40-over contest, Jain chased down the target with one over to spare with Liyan Khan top-scoring with an unbeaten 65.

In the other quarterfinals, University of Madras went down to Jamia Millia Islamia while Bombay had no difficulty in disposing of API Rewa University.

Heavy overnight showers forced postponement of the other last-eight battle between Jiwaji University and Jainpuri University to Wednesday.
