> Only three swimmers represented India at the world championship with two others being Khade and Sejwal. Since Khade and Sejwal had attained the 'B' Standard time or the OST mark, the duo was not eligible to get a berth under Universality Place which opened the door for Gagan.

It is debatable how FINA chose to give the Universality Places overlooking those who had attained OST.
