MS Engineering- Aerospace programme

Programmes: Aerospace Engineering - Aerodynamics (AD); Aerospace Engineering - Aerospace Structures (ST); Aerospace Engineering - Aerospace Propulsion; Aerospace Engineering - Avionics (AV); Aerospace Engineering - Manufacture & Management (M&M).

Eligibility required is a pass in the prescribed qualifying degree examination or equivalent with not less than 50 per cent (for SC/ST 45 per cent marks) in the aggregate. They must have been in service for a period of at least two years and should be sponsored by the respective organisation.
