Aerospace courses offered

Bengaluru: Jain University has invited applications for MS Engineering (Aerospace) programme facilitating students to attend classes during in the evenings at its centre in the city. The programme has been designed for executives working in the engineering industry and R&D establishments to enhance their knowledge and career. It has been drawn up in consultation with employers like aircraft industries (India and abroad), aerospace R&D, airlines, airports and academic institutions. The programmes include aerospace engineering - aerodynamics (AD), aerospace engineering - aerospace structures (ST), aerospace engineering - avionics (AV) and aerospace engineering - manufacturing & maintenance management (M&M). Pass percentage in the prescribed qualifying degree examination or equivalent with not less than 50% (for SC/ST 45%) in the aggregate is necessary. Candidates should be working for at least two years and should be sponsored by respective organisations. The course duration is minimum two years and maximum four years. December 27 is the last date for applying. Entrance test and counseling will be held on January 12, 2014.
