Corruption and maladministration are conjoined twins: justice Hegde

"Corruption and maladministration are like conjoined twins, they cannot survive without each other", said justice N Santosh Hegde, Lokayukta, as he opposed the regularisation of unauthorised housing layouts under the Akrama-Sakrama scheme. Speaking at the Jagruti Habba, an event organised by the students of Sri Bhagavan Mahaveer Jain College, Hegde said, "Corruption flourishes in the country Political parties come, improve their own financial status, leaving the people they are meant to serve in the same state," justice Hegde said. The Habba, organised by the Kannada literature and culture wing of the college, was meant to create greater awareness among the general public.
