## Summer school on quantitative methods in political science research

**T**he Jain University, in collaboration with faculty from international universities like the University of California, Berkeley, Ohio State University, Columbus, Brown University and Harvard University, has been conducting a summer school on quantitative methods in political science research from May 14. The Centre for the Study of Developing Societies (CSDS) is partnering in the programme and partial support has also been received from the Indian Council for Social Science Research. Twenty participants for the summer school were selected after a rigorous process of scrutiny. They are young research students and lecturers from universities, colleges and research institutions from across 15 states. The 10-day residential programme involves hands-on training in the use of quantitative methods in political science research. The core faculty for the programme are scholars actively involved in survey research and quantitative analysis. The team is led by Prof Pradeep Chhibber (University of California, Berkeley) and Prof Irfan Nooruddin (Ohio State University, Columbus). The workshop is meant to enhance the research skills of students and the teaching community by providing a holistic insight into the current quantitative research tools ■
