Akshay takes round 1 honours

Akshay Chopra of SBRR Mahajana First Grade College, Mysore put in a stupendous show to grab the lead from overnight leader Prajwal SD of Sri Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain College on the final day of round one in the boys category of the Aaspire Vie 2011 Inter-Collegiate tenpin bowling event.

Akshay who finished his first game with a steady 176, bowled strongly in the second and hit a turkey in the last frame to score 211, thereby tallying a pinfall of 387 (average 193.5) to edge past Prajwal by three pins to finish on top. Rajeev Kaushik of Dayanand Sagar College and Jatin Dodia of Jain Business School are tied at third position. Following the conclusion of Round One, the top 64 boys will go on to play two more games in round two to add to their tally from round one, following which the top 32 players will go on to play round three.

JAYADEVI RALLIES TO TOP

In the Girls' category, the top 32 girls from round one concluded their allotted two games in round two to fight for a spot in the top 16 for round three. Jaydevi from Jain International Residential School, who was in second position after round one, recorded a pinfall of 245 in her two games to finish to the top position. Pavithra of Centre of Management Studies, who was in third position after round one, also played steadily to record a pinfall of 241 and a total pinfall of 492 to take the second spot. Overnight leader Karishma had a low first game and finished with a pinfall of 185 and a total of 462 to take the third spot. Round Three of the girls' category will see the 16 girls indulging in knockout matches against each other in tennis format. This will be followed by the quarter finals, semi finals and the finals.
