Prajwal, Ashwini take early lead in first round

PRAJWAL S D of Sri Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain College bounced back from a slow start to take the lead in the first round of the Boys' category of the VIE 2011 Inter Collegiate Tenpin Bowling Championship organised by Jain University under the auspices of KSTBA, being held at Star City, Bangalore.

Prajwal, who scored a relatively low 159 in the first game, made strong comeback in the second game, hitting five strikes in a row to score 225, finishing with an average of 192 and taking the top spot in the leaderboard thus far. Following him closely is Rajeev Kaushik of Dayanand Sagar College who scored an average of 188.5 over two games.

Leading the Girls' category thus far is Ashwini Jaisimha, also of Sri Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain College, who scored a total pinfall of 231 and an average of 115.5 in her first round entry of two games.
