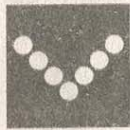

Karishma forges ahead



KARISHMA Gulecha of JIRS came up with consistent bowling to score a impressive pinfall of 277 in two games to take

the first round lead in girls section of the VIE 2011 inter-collegiate tenpin bowling championships at Star City on Friday. Behind Karishma is her teammate Jayadevi, who scored a pinfall of 254. Pavithra of Center of Management Studies is third with a pinfall of 251. Overnight leader Ashwini slumped to the fourth spot.

The boys' category witnessed some notable performances. Jatin Dodia of Jain Business School looked on course to overtake leader Prajwal S D (Sri Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain College), scoring 180 in the first game and going into the tenth frame of his second game with a turkey, but unfortunately landed a split, thereby scoring 197 in the second game, finishing with a total pinfall of 377 and sharing the second place with Rajeev Kaushik (Dayanand Sagar College). Ashish Jain from Manipal University shook off an average score of 149 in the first game to post a score of 223 in the second game, thereby propelling him to third place in

the leaderboard so far.
