

'JNANAARNAVA' - Science Expo 2011

'JNANAARNAVA' Science Expo-2011, an Intercollegiate Science Exhibition of Working Projects and Models were organized by the Department of Science, Jain University, J C Road campus. The exhibition was inaugurated by **Dr. S Ananth Raj**, Executive Secretary, Vision Group on Science and Technology (VGST) and Scientific officer, **Dr.S Satish, Director P&PR, ISRO Head quarters, Bangalore** and **Dr. S Somashekar** were also present at the inauguration as Chief guests.

Around 400 students from 10 colleges participated from all the science departments like Physics, Life science, BCA, Animation, Forensic Science, Interior design, Psychology etc. There were 175 interesting and creative projects presented by the students which included Green House Monitoring System, Surveillance Robots, Object Counter, Hover Craft, Solar Cell, Foucault Pendulum, Wooden Air Craft, Microbial Fuel Cells, Bio Diesel from Algae and Fishes, Prenatal Development, Pavlov Conditioning and many more.

The exhibition was a creative platform for both students and the teachers to express their talent and creativity. The students explained the technology and applications of the Projects/Models to around 4000 visitors including the students and public.

The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) exhibited different scale down satellite models of CHANGRAYANA, GSAT-8, PSLV, GSLV-MK-III, and CARTSAT-2. Some of the models of recently launched satellites were exhibited first time by ISRO in this exhibition.
