Jain (Deemed-to-be-University) – School of Law & Governance invites applications for Law Faculty positions at the level of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor. The scale of pay for these positions will be as per the University norms.

Candidates with good academic record, teaching / research experience and working in related areas of research are encouraged to apply.

Essential Qualifications for Assistant Professor:

- Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree level in Law from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- The candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET / SET etc.
- An eminent scholar with a doctoral degree (Ph.D.) in Law.
- Preference would be given to candidates having teaching experience / working experience in law firms / industry or equivalent.

Essential Qualifications for Associate Professor:

- Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree level in Law from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- An eminent scholar with a doctoral degree (Ph.D.) in Law.
- A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching at the University, College level and/or research in University/national level institutions excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degree.
- A minimum of five publications in the peer reviewed/UGC listed journals.
- Contribution to educational innovation, such as designing of new curricula, courses and/or outstanding performing achievement in the field of specialization.

Essential Qualifications for Professor:

- Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's degree level in Law from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- An eminent scholar with a doctoral degree (Ph.D.) in Law.
- A minimum of ten years of experience of teaching at the University, College level and/or research in University/national level institutions including experience of guiding research at doctoral level with outstanding performing achievements in the field of specialization.



- A minimum of 10 research publications in the peer reviewed/ UGC listed journals.
- Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.

Relaxation in educational qualifications, experience, age, etc., in the case of reserved category candidates will be given as per rules. Candidates belonging to SC / ST category must submit appropriate certificates issued by the competent authority recently as per the format prescribed by the Government of India.
