

She works in research and teaching at the Technical University of Lausanne, in Switzerland.

Hadia Hosny (Egypt) finished an impressive career in badminton, but has two gigantic additions: she is a professor at the British University of Egypt, she has a master's degree in biomedicine from the University of Bath, UK, and a doctorate in pharmacology from University of Cairo and has researched and published articles on an anti-inflammatory drug used for various diseases. Charlotte Hym (France), debuted in the "street skateboarding", when she gets off the board she is a doctor in neuroscience and her current job is to investigate the effect of the mother's voice on the development of motor skills in The new-borns.

Louise Shanahan (Ireland) was preparing for Paris 2024 but managed to qualify for Tokyo in the 800 meters of athletics.

She is a graduate of Quantum Physics from the University of Cork, Ireland, and is pursuing her PhD at the University of Cambridge, England. She studies and develops devices to improve cancer diagnosis and treatment.

Nadine Apetz (Germany) is the first German boxer in an Olympics, with which she already has her own merit.

Nadine has a master's degree in Neuroscience from the University of Bremen and hopes to complete a doctorate at Cologne University Hospital.

Apetz is studying a technique called deep brain stimulation, which involves applying electrical or electromagnetic currents to certain areas of the "Gray matter" of the brain: the goal, to help Parkinson's patients.

Gabby Thomas (United States) was a bronze medalist in the 200 meters of athletics and is already a legend in the discipline for being the third fastest woman in history in that specialty.

But Gabby studied Neurobiology and Global Health at Harvard University, is pursuing a master's degree in epidemiology and health management at the University of Texas at Austin, and her work focuses on the investigation of racial inequality in access to health services. health in USA





Andrea Murez (Israel) is a swimmer who participated in 50-, 100- and 200-meters freestyle and 4x100 mixed relays. But she out of the pool she is a biologist from Stanford University, in the US.

The performance of the Institution - Distinctive to its Priority and Thrust

Driven by a strong belief that sports can be used as a strategy for individual character development and to nurture National pride in youngsters, the University has, for more than a decade of its existence, relentlessly pursued the path of preparing its students to excel at the National/International level in a complex and competitive environment. Jain (Deemed-to-be University) has carved a niche for itself as a premier Institution in the country in the field of sports.

The efforts of the University, supported by an enabling sports policy, has translated into positive outcomes for the Society in general and for India/State of Karnataka in particular. Aditi Ashok represented India in Golf in the 2016 Summer Olympics in Brazil and has also won the Ladies European Tour title. Two students of Jain University represented India in 2012 London Olympics namely Gagan Ullamath (Swimming), and Sharath Gayakwad (Paralympic swimmer and an Arjuna Awardee). Niranjan Mukund, a para swimmer, won Gold and Silver at the World Series, 2019 in Brazil. Ashwini Bhat, Badminton player was ranked 33 in world tour ranking for women's doubles, and ranked among the top 100 in the world and has represented India in the All England Badminton Championship. . Besides, the University has produced a number of reputed cricket players who have played for India/Karnataka State and in the IPL like KL Rahul, Mayank Agarwal, H S Sharath, Shreyas Gopal, Prasidh Krishna, Suchit Jagadeesh, Karun Nair, Samarth, KP Appanna, Abrar Kazi, Akshay Kodoth in Ranji Trophy, One-day Internationals, Test Cricket and T20. Archana Kamath is a National Champion in Table Tennis. Srihari Nataraj holds national records in Swimming and won two gold medals in Uzbekistan open championships and is a strong contender for Tokyo Olympics. Shika Gautham, badminton player, is a National Champion and No. 1 women's doubles player and represented India in the All-England Badminton Championship.

The University has always excelled in Team events. JAIN (Deemed-to-be University), the Southern Champs, won the All-India Toyota *University Cricket Championship 2013* after beating Northern Stars – Jamia Milia Islamia, New Delhi.



The University has developed state of the art sports infrastructure, which is used not only by students of the University, but also for conducting National level events attracting talent from across the country. The Government of India has bestowed the honor on the University of hosting the 2nd edition of "Khelo India" in Bangalore in 2022. Shri. Kiren Rijiju, the Sports Minister of India, announced this on 23rd February 2021. All India events conducted by the University so far include the Inter-University Aquatic Championships in 2014 and 2019 hosting 1200 and 2500 participants respectively from 120+ Universities and 4 editions of "My Country Run" with 40,000 + participants, duly listed in India Book of Records and Asia Book of Records for records as the "Largest 5 KM Run to Encourage sports and Health".

The University has taken the following proactive steps to promote excellence in sports:

- > Scholarship for deserving sports students based on their academic year performance
- Coaching and mentoring support
- Special attendance, gracing and continuous evaluation norms as per a uniquely designed Sports Policy.
- Counselling by experts, based on "Positive Psychology"
- Special coaching and a separate exam time table for sports students to perform equally well in academics
- > Cash Awards for Sports Achievers at the University/National/International level
- Free/Concessional Hostel facility.
- Provision of Nutrition and Dietary supplements.
- Playing Kit to all Sports Students

Sports Infrastructure at JAIN

<u>The sports infrastructure differentiates the University from among its peers</u>. They cater to the requirements of various indoor and outdoor games. <u>Indoor games</u> that can be hosted include badminton, basketball, Table Tennis, Squash, Billiards and Snooker, Bowling, Taekwondo, Karate, Aerobics with facilities like Sauna and Jacuzzi.



The ultra-modern <u>aquatic complex</u> is equipped with 25 metres - 08 lane short course swimming pool, 50 meters - 10 lanes competition pool with water-polo facilities and a separate diving pool with standard fixed and spring diving boards. It also has a covered gallery to seat 1000 spectators on the either side of the pool.

The 200000 square feet lush green 'Oval', a well-designed *cricket ground*, with 5 strips of turf wicket in the centre. An additional cricket ground features International standard 65m natural turf with 6 Outdoor and 6 Indoor practice nets. Both the grounds are suitable for hosting International and National level Cricket matches

The <u>Tennis infrastructure</u> includes 04 plexi-cushioned and two clay tennis courts of a high standard. Additional exclusive facilities include 1 Centre Court with a seating/viewing capacity for about 200 people, 6 Synthetic Courts, 2 Practice Clay Courts, 7 ITF Classified Acrylic Cushioned Tennis Courts with floodlights. BWF standard 12 wooden indoor synthetic Badminton courts

An international class <u>Golf driving range</u> has also been developed. A double tier spacious driving range fitted with ultramodern Golf training and analysis equipment has been designed. The PDR with 20 hitting bays is supplemented with a well laid out practice range having a huge putting green, chipping area and a bunker shot practice. In addition to these facilities, a six-hole Golf course of international specifications has also been developed to make Golf training programmes effective and complete.

The <u>Equestrian Centre</u> caters to horse-riding as a sport. With ten horses and two ponies in its table, horse riding is one of the most popular sports disciplines on campus. In case of horses, a rider has to inculcate important aspects of animal health care such as grooming and caring. Students get the opportunity to watch the trainers and doctors take care of the animals and imbibe the finer aspects of animal rearing. The full- fledged <u>Gymnasium</u> is equipped with the latest equipment for physical conditioning. This Air- Conditioned Multi-Purpose Gymnasium has facilities such as Chest Conditioner and Press Station [80 kgs], Dipping, Leg Press [100 kgs], Seated Rowing [75 kgs], Latissimus Station [75 kgs], Peck Deck [75 kgs.] etc.



Out of five <u>Volleyball</u> courts and four <u>Basketball</u> courts, two Basketball courts are provided with latest lighting facilities to enable night time practice. An additional 2 FIBA standard Basketball courts and a half-court with floodlight facility have been commissioned.

A FIFA Quality Pro Certified <u>Artificial Turf Football field</u> measuring 108m x 68m and an additional lush <u>green turf football field</u> that is fitted with pop-up sprinklers meet the requirements to conduct of National level tournaments

A <u>natural turf Hockey ground</u> of international standard fitted with Pop-up sprinklers, a 400 meters natural track, athletic arena and a covered stand with a capacity for more than 5000 seating spectators are additional sports facilities at JAIN.



Facilities - Sports Infrastructure

Stemming from the vision of overall student development, Jain (Deemed-to-be University) provides facilities and encouragement for every sport that students find interest in. Exceptional talents are given adequate encouragement in their chosen sporting disciplines.

The University offers scholarships to help athletes who compete at state, national or international levels to meet the extra costs of elite participation. The scheme provides personal academic coaching, complete tuition fee waiver, free access to the University sports facilities, and guaranteed University accommodation for the duration of study.



Glimpse of Sports Facilities

Sprintoor: Is a multi-sports indoor stadium with a total built up area of 80,000 square feet. The stadium houses:

- 4 badminton courts with Gerflo synthetic flooring
- > 1 basketball court with wooden flooring
- > Table Tennis Hall with 15 tables
- > 2 squash courts with viewer's gallery
- ➤ Billiards and Snooker Hall with 6 tables
- ➤ Bowling Alley 4 lane
- Well-equipped & air-conditioned gyms
- Cardio fitness center
- > Aerobic center
- > Sauna, steam and jacuzzi





<u>Sprintoor – Multi Sports Indoor Stadium</u>

Sprintoor also has well-furnished accommodation with a capacity of 75 beds, a VIP lounge, cafeteria, projector room, media room, and a reception lobby.

The Aqua: Is an ultra-modern aquatic complex. The Aqua comprises an 8-lane 25 mtr. short course swimming pool, a 10-lane 50 mtr. competition pool with water polo facilities, and a separate diving pool with standard fixed and spring diving boards. It also has a covered gallery to seat 1,000 spectators on either side of the pools. The Aqua can host competitions including water polo, diving and synchronized swimming.

The Oval: The 2 lakh sq. feet Oval is a well-designed cricket ground of international standard with 5 strips of turf wicket in the center making it suitable to host national and international level matches. It has a pavilion with facilities such as dressing rooms, massage rooms, umpire's cabins, and a dining hall with viewer's gallery. The ground also has 10 practice pitches – 7 turfs and 3 cements.



About VIE

VIE, an All-India Sports Extravaganza, is an annual event hosted by JAIN (Deemed-to-be University). The University sees an outstanding performance and participation of students from than 50 colleges in various indoor and outdoor sporting events.

To strive for superiority and to compete is what VIE describes. And this all-India sports fest has always seen every year, as the steppingstone to success and to achieve greater heights.

The past is what makes us the present and the present is what makes the future. The times of yore has determined the magnificence of VIE which has been a cut above all the sports fest held in India.

Sharath on cloud nine

Archana edges past Krittwika for women's title

Veteran A. Sharath Kamal and youngster Archana Kamath scripted history, becoming the singles National champion in men's and women's events, respectively, on the concluding day of the 80th HSports National Table Tennis Championship in the grand finale at the J.N. Indoor Stadium arena.

While Sharath saved a match point before scraping past his Petroleum Sports Promotion Board (PSPB) teammate G. Sathiyan for a record ninth National championship title, Archana became the second-youngest women's National champion after edging past West Bengal's Krittwika Sinha Roy.

In the final, Archana started well, but with both tied at 1-1, Krittwika surged ahead 9-4.

Archana then showed her all-round game to clinch seven points on the trot to take the lead. In the fourth game too, Krittwika led 9-6, but the 18-year-old bounced back with a four-point streak to nose ahead.

Krittwika returned well in the fifth game to narrow the margin but couldn't match Archana's speed in the sixth and ended up on the losing side in her second appearance in a National final.

Big scalp

In the semifinal, Archana had shocked Manika Batra II-7, II-7, II-7, 6-II, II-8.

The Sharath-Sathiyan affair then lived up to its reputation with the World No. 30 and 31 engaged in a fierce battle – both in terms of quality and tactics. At 10-8 in the fifth game,

At 10-8 in the fifth game, Sharath had the opportunity to take a 3-2 lead but Sathiyan came back to level scores and Sharath missed his serve to hand the game over to his Chennai junior.

In the decider, Sharath opened up a 5-2 lead but after change of sides, he missed a forehand and a backhand top-spin to give Sathiyan a window who raced ahead 7-5. At 10-9, Sathiyan had a match point but netted a backhand topspin return.

Sharath then converted his third match point to overhaul Kamlesh Mehta's record of eight National titles and went down on the mat in disbelief.

DISTINGUISHED 3-TO-BE UNIVERSITY

KL Rahul



Born in Mangalore in April 1992, he started playing cricket at the age of 11 and moved to Bengaluru to pursue his career in cricket from Jain University. During the felicitation ceremony held at the Jain University in 2016, the alumni was honored for his remarkable performance.

Rahul credited his success to the University. "I always used to ask the Sports Director about the numbers of classes I need to attend and he told me to get back onto the cricket field and

not to worry about my attendance. It was this sort of support that gave me the freedom to concentrate on my game and succeed," he said. He has also been a part of Sports Award Ceremony organized by the University. One of the brightest stars in the Indian cricket team, the following are just some of his achievements.

He was a part of 2010 ICC Under-19 Cricket World Cup.

In 2013, KL Rahul represented Jain University in an inter-collegiate cricket tournament and scored a century which helped Jain University record a 39-run win over University of Madras in the final match of the South Zone inter-university cricket championship. With his record of the fastest batsman to have scored centuries in all three cricket matches, he also became first triple-centurion for Karnataka in first-class.

He made his international debut in the 2014-15 Test series played against Australia at Melbourne and scored his maiden Test century in his second Test match. Rahul became the first Indian to score a century on One Day International debut and the first Indian opener to score a century in his debut Test in the West Indies, the third Indian to score a century in all three formats of international cricket, and score a ton in the first innings as opener in both Tests and ODIs.

In June 2016, he scored a century on his One Day International debut against Zimbabwe becoming the first Indian cricketer to do so on the debut match.

He plays for Karnataka in the domestic circuit and Kings XI Punjab in the Indian Premier League. Rahul made his Indian Premier League (IPL) debut in 2013 for Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) as a wicket-keeper batsman. Playing for Kings XI Punjab in the 2018 IPL, he scored the fastest 50 in IPL history. For his performances in the 2018 and 2019 IPL seasons, he was named in the Cricinfo and Cricbuzz IPL XI.

For all of us, to receive recognition from established and renowned personalities in the field is an achievement in itself. In an interview with the Press Trust of India, Chris Gayle spoke of KL Rahul as an extraordinary talent who had the ability to match Virat Kohli's feats. This remark coming from one of the greatest Jamaican batsmen holding numerous records would no doubt be special.

DISTINGUISHED SPORTS PERSON

Pankaj Advani

Dreaming of what we want to be when we grow up is something all of us have done. For most of us, it would be multiple professions at the same time. But to grow up determined and focused on one profession and to take it up seriously is admirable. Introduced to the game at the age of 10 by his elder brother and winning his first ever title at 12, Pankaj Advani, the 21-time World Billiards and Snooker Champion has become synonymous with snooker and billiards and making winning a habit.

Pankaj Advani completed his bachelor's degree in Commerce from Jain (Deemed-to-be University) to which he owes his success. On his association with Jain (Deemed-to-be University), Pankaj shared, "When I joined the college, I was worried how I would manage time for snooker and billiards tournaments along with academics. But the University understood my passion for sports and supported me through my education. Its policy of maintaining a balance between academics and sports is commendable. I have always been grateful to the Institute for my achievements."

Spotting the talent, passion, natural ability, and dedication for the sport in him, former national Snooker champion Arvind Savur took him under his wing. Advani has to his credit several records at the state and national levels. In 2000, he won his first Indian Junior Billiards Championship title and won it again in 2001 and 2003. He was the youngest National Snooker Champion to win the India Junior Snooker Championship in 2003. He became a snooker professional in 2012. Advani won the 2014 IBSF World 6-Red Snooker Championship, on his debut in that discipline. The only player to win the world titles in both formats of snooker (long and short formats) as well as billiards (time and point formats), he holds the World, Asian, and Indian National Championship titles simultaneously.

The world champion cueist's list of achievements is endless. Here's a look at some of them:

- India's first world champion in 6-red snooker
- Won the IBSF World Billiards Championship in 2005 at Qawra, Malta
- Only Indian to have won the amateur world title in both snooker and billiards
- The only person to have won all five national, regional, and world billiards tournaments in a single season.
- Won the WPBSA billiards title at Leeds in 2009
- Holds the record of being the first in the world to win the trio of the WPBSA World Billiards Champion pro title (which he has held in 2009 and 2012).
- Won the Asian Billiards Championship in Goa in 2012 becoming the first player to win 5 Asian Billiards Champion titles
- Won the first ever World Team Billiards Championship held in Glasgow, Scotland in August 2014 along with Rupesh Shan, Devendra Joshi, and Ashok Shandilya.
- Is the first player to hold the world title and the continental title at the same time in 2016
- Won the Asian Team Snooker Championship in 2017

DISTINGUISHED -BE UNIVERSITY

Sharath M. Gayakwad



The gem cannot be polished without friction, nor man perfected without trials is a Chinese proverb. This is true for all of us because although we are born with abilities, we go through trials to realize this. Life has shown and keeps showing us that nothing is impossible when you have the determination, focus, support, and the will to succeed. We read stories of how people overcome difficulties to come out successful. So, to have one of our very own go through the same and carve a name for himself in the world of sports is

admirable.

Born with a deformed left hand, Sharath M. Gayakwad was apprehensive of joining swimming classes initially because of his disability, but eventually took up swimming at the age of 9 and participated in several swimming events for the disabled. However, his physical deformity made it hard for him to maintain the equilibrium.

Spotting him at a school event, John Christopher took him under his wing, trained him for 7 years and worked tirelessly to prepare him for competitions making this the beginning of a beautiful journey.

In 2003, Sharath got his first taste of success at the age of 12, when he won two gold medals in his first swimming competition. Overcoming challenges at every step, the Indian Paralympic swimmer from Bengaluru has won 55 domestic and 41 international medals - 4 Gold, 15 Silver, and 22 Bronze. He won four Gold, two Silver and two Bronze at the IWAS World Games in 2008; was a medalist in the IWAS Games held in Taipei and in Bangalore in 2009, respectively; won a bronze medal at the 2010 Asian Para Games, Guangzhou, China; and won a Silver and 2 Bronze medals at the 2011 International Deutsche Meisterschaften (IDM) Swimming Championships in Berlin, Germany. Sharath was the first Indian swimmer to qualify for the 2012 London Paralympics. He won six medals at the 2014 Asian Games and surpassed P.T. Usha's record for the greatest number of medals by an Indian at a global multidiscipline event. Sharath was also the Asian record-holder in 2 categories – 50m Butterfly and 50m Breaststroke from 2010 to 2013.

Sharath was honored with the Arjuna Award in 2015 and was listed along with Indian sportspersons, gymnast, Dipa Karmakar and freestyle wrestler, Sakshi Malik by Forbes magazine among their Under-30 Super achievers in Asia in 2017.

A proud alumnus of Jain (Deemed-to-be University), his alma mater was also a source of encouragement where his training is concerned. "I joined on a sports quota with a good concession and was given time for training. My college was very supportive. They would hold special classes for me as I would spend six hours on training."

Now a coach in Bengaluru, he spends six hours a day coaching kids, some of them who are differently-abled. Sharath is also a co-founder of Gamatics, a venture that offers high performance practice gears and equipment for swimmers.



Aditi Ashok



Born on March 29, 1998 in Bangalore, Aditi Ashok started playing golf at the age of 5. Since then, there has been no looking back for the Indian professional golfer who was the first to play in the Asian Youth Games in 2013, Youth Olympic Games and Asian Games in 2014, and Olympic Games in 2016. The dream to play in the Olympics at the age of 5 began to take shape with her first national title at the age of 9 which set the ball rolling for the wins that followed in the later years.

Among the many accolades under her belt, are victories at the Ladies British Amateur Strokeplay Championship at Leeds in 2015; the Q School International Tour in 2015; the Hero Women's Indian Open in 2016 becoming the first Indian to win a Ladies European Tour (LET) title; the Qatar Ladies Open in 2016; the LET's Rookie of the Year award in 2016; Lalla Aicha Ladies European Tour in Morocco in 2016; and Fatima Bint Mubarak Ladies Open in 2017. In 2017, Aditi played in all 5 of the major tournaments and shone in both the ANA Inspiration (T-42) and the PGA Championship (T-29).

A regular on the Ladies European Tour and Ladies Professional Golf Association (LPGA) Tour, she's made her presence felt with notable performances and achievements at the (2011) USHA Karnataka Junior, Southern India Junior, Faldo Series Asia-India, East India Tolly Ladies, All India Championship; (2012) USHA Delhi Ladies, USHA Army Championship, All India Junior; (2013) Asia Pacific Junior Championship; (2014) Eastern India Ladies Amateur, USHA IGU All India Ladies & Girls Championship; (2015) Army Ladies & Junior Championship, St. Rule Trophy, Southern India Ladies & Junior Girls Championship, and the Thailand Amateur Open.

Currently ranked 130 in the world, Aditi has her sight set on a LPGA win, and with the determination and talent that we know her for, that may be on the horizon.







Annexure-I

GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION OF INDIAN NATIONAL **UNIVERSITY TEAMS/ATHLETES**

FISU GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

I. General Eligibility

- 1. The athletes:
 - A. be a national of the country they represent;
 - B. born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 2003;
 - C. students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute, the status of which is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
 - D. Former students of the institutions mentioned in c) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year preceding the event.*

II. General Guidelines for Selection of Indian Universities National Team/Athlete

- 2.1. Merit will be based on Individual score and not the team score for individual events.
- 2.2. The decision of the selection committee will be final and binding.
- 2.3. Participation in WUG 2021: The other expenditure i.e. travel expenses, registration fee, incidental charges, playing kit, ceremonial dress, local transport, visa fee, accommodation charges, participation fee etc., will be borne by the concerned universities.

2.4. Selection Trials:

- A. Registration Fee: of Rs. 1000 per athlete.
- B. Boarding and Lodging: For boarding and lodging Rs. 500/- per headper day from athletes & officials (concerned University) may be charged by the host/organizing university.
- C. By taking into consideration the prevailing pandemic situation and involvement elite sports persons in Olympics or other recognized international tournaments/national camp/trials etc, the Selection Committee with prior information shared to AIU may consider absentia to an athlete on the basis of his credential at international level. To avail of this exemption, the athlete will submit their application with documentary proof to AIU duly endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor of the concerned university.
- D. After the selection trial, a national camp may be allocated by AIU to a member University and the information of the same will be conveyed to the respective universities by host/organizing University in due course of time.

Annexure-II

SWIMMING

Sports Specific Eligibility of Players/Teams for participation in Selection Trails of the Indian Universities Swimming Team (Men & Women)

1. Top 8 (eight) athletes (in each category as mentioned in FISU Regulations for the WUG-2021) of the 1st Khelo India University Games 2020.

Or

2. Players who were top 8 (eight) in Senior or Junior National Championship of last 3 (three) years (from 1st July 2017 onward).

Or

3. Top 8 Players in Khelo India Youth Games-2020/School Games may be considered for trails.

4. An International player who has represented India in Senior or Junior categories of last 3 (three) years (from 1st July 2017 onward).

Or

- 5. Players who have extraordinary international sports credentials or top scores / results at Indian national trials of concerned sports but not covered under above mentioned categories, may also apply for the selection trials to AIU. After duly scrutinizing their performance by the expert committee of AIU, the eligible players will be informed accordingly.
- 6. It may please be noted that the players of above-mentioned categories for selection trials is to be recommended by the Director Sports/Head of the Sports Department/DSW of concerned Universities.
- 7. Merit will be based on Individual score and not the team score.
- 8. The decision of the Selection Committee will be final and binding.



Khelo India University Games 2021 medallists

Jain University led the KIUG 2021 medals tally with 20 golds, ahead of Lovely Professional University's 17. Get the full list of medal winners.



The **Khelo India University Games 2021** started in Bengaluru on April 24 and ended on May 3.

The hosts **Jain University** won the **KIUG 2021** title with 20 gold medals. They also won seven silvers and five bronze, taking their overall medal tally to 32.

Jain University won the second KIUG championship by claiming three more gold medals than their closest competitors Lovely Professional University (17 gold, 15 silver, 19 bronze).

Lovely Professional University ended up with the most medals (51). Defending champions Panjab University finished third (15 gold, 9 silver, 24 bronze).



A total of 142 universities won a medal at the Khelo India University Games 2021, from which 71 won at least one gold.

As many as 259 gold medals, 258 silvers and 335 bronze medals were awarded at KIUG 2021.

Swimmer Siva Sridhar of Jain University won the most number of individual medals at KIUG 2021, winning 7 golds and two silvers. Swimmer Shrungi Bandekar was the most successful female athlete at KIUG 2021 with four golds and one silver.

The KIUG is a part of the Indian government's **Khelo India** initiative to promote grassroots sports and identify young talents from all across the country.

The event is an inter-university meet where athletes representing different institutes from all over the country vie for medals in a variety of sporting events.

Some 3,800 participants representing 189 universities participated across 20 sporting disciplines. This edition also witnessed the addition of two indigenous sports, yogasana and <u>mallakhamb</u>, to the programme.

Top Indian athletes, including several Olympians like **Dutee Chand**, **Srihari Nataraj**, **Aishwary Pratap Singh Tomar** and **Divyansh Singh Panwar** took part in KIUG 2021.

Academic Programs in Sports

Introduction

The Global Sports Market reached a value of nearly \$488.5 billion in 2020, having grown at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 4.3% since 2014, and is expected to grow at a CAGR of 5.9% to nearly \$614.1 billion by 2022. Growth in the historic period resulted from the emerging markets growth and rapid urbanization. Factors that negatively affected growth in the historic period were unfavorable climate changes and shortages of sports professionals. Going forward, increasing sports sponsorships, growing popularity of e-sports, economic growth, an increase in the number of Internet accessible devices and the emergence of multiple sports channels to capture viewership will drive growth. Factors that could hinder the growth of this market in the future are an increasing threat from home entertainment and increasing regulations on sports.

The sports market is segmented by type of engagement into participatory sports and spectator sports. The participatory sports market accounted for the largest share of the sports market in 2018 at 56.4%. The spectator sports market is expected to be the fastest-growing segment going forward at a CAGR of 5.9%. The spectator sports market is segmented by type into sports teams and clubs, and racing and individual sports. The sports teams and clubs market accounted for the largest share of the spectator sports market in 2020 at 72.5%. It is expected to grow the fastest going forward at a CAGR of 6.8%. The participatory sports market is segmented by type into fitness and recreational sports centres, golf courses and country clubs, and others - participatory sports, marinas, bowling centres, and skiing facilities. The fitness and recreational sports centres market accounted for the largest share of the participatory sports market in 2020 at 39.8%. The others - participatory sports market is expected to grow the fastest going forward at a CAGR of 8.4%.

The sports market is also segmented by type of revenue source into gate revenue, media rights, sponsorship and merchandising. The sports market by media rights was the largest segment of the sports market in 2020 at 23.7%. The sports market by merchandising is expected to be the fastest-growing segment going forward at a CAGR of 7%.

India is no longer just a cricket-loving nation. It is welcoming other sports with equal warmth and support as well. Many other games are now experiencing growth in viewership, participation, and sports-related industries that was once experienced exclusively by cricket. It has opened up new avenues and business opportunities for investors---these range from fields like brand building and infrastructure to niche entrepreneurial ventures, emerging technologies, and services. But the biggest factor is the changing outlook of the population towards sports and fitness. All the above factors are fuelling an increase in the demand for sports-related goods and services.

The Indian government has turned its attention to develop the sports sector as a strategy to spur employment, generate additional revenue, and attract foreign investment into the nation,



apart from nurturing sports talent to bring in laurels for the country. For instance, the federal government's Khelo India program, for which it set aside a massive Rs 1,756 crores. A national committee was also set up recently to study the state of sports governance. The committee includes some of the most reputed sportspersons, marketing professionals specialized in sports and leading sports brands along with government officials.

The private sector is also witnessing a deeper involvement in sports governance. Earlier it was limited only to deals associated with public-private partnerships for specific task-related tenders, like stadium management or overhaul of facilities. Following the rise of IPL, ISL, Hockey India League, Pro-Kabaddi League and Premier Badminton League in the last decade, the Sports Management Industry in India has seen a significant growth eg. IPL alone has grown 5 folds since its inception, employing over 15000 people.

The sports management business growth has come primarily on the back of the rising corporate interest in sports. With TV and digital medium providing sports as 'sportainment', coupled with regional feeds for sports events, advertising and sponsorship, interest in sports has increased exponentially. Football registered a 227 per cent increase from Rs 265 million in 2013 to Rs 603 million in 2014, due to ISL, while the two tennis leagues and the two kabaddi leagues saw a 1,064 % jump from Rs 70 million to Rs 745 million. We're surely in the most exciting times for sports and sports management.
