

Enactus 2015: Joint Faculty Advisors Training Programme

The co-faculty advisors of team ENACTUS, the student organization of School of Commerce and Management Studies, Jain University attended a two day training programme conducted by ENACTUS India at Infosys BPO, Mysore.

Day 1: Introduction and training
