

Theme - Case as a pedagogical tool

Case study method effectively focuses on logical and analytical skills, decision making in complex situations and coping with ambiguities. This method is quite helpful in understanding the theoretical concepts, application of managerial tools and learning unique managerial situations along with problem solving techniques. Thus, case writing and its analysis is considered as a strong factor to enhance the skills of a faculty.
