Guidelines for Submission of Papers

- Authors can submit their full papers through an e-mail attachment to: jainuniversity.conf@gmail.com
- The paper should not exceed 3000 words and it should contain an abstract of 100-200 words
- The main title should be followed by name, affiliation and address of the author(s) with e-mail
- The paper should be in MS-word format, font: Times New Roman, size: 12, space 1.5 lines, paper size: A4, keyword: 2-5 words, paper length: 3-8 pages
- All references should be presented according to the APA Style
- The paper should be sent along with the declaration letter stating that the work is the original and not presented/published anywhere else
- Papers approved by the conference review committee will be accepted for the oral presentation
