

CERSSE Completes Phase 1 of Training of Trainers (TOT) in Myanmar - Forum of Federations Project

The Centre for Research in Social Sciences and Education (CERSSE) has been associated with the Forum of Federation's Capacity Building for Democracy and Decentralization in Myanmar. Between 10 and 18 October, a major Training of Trainers programme was conducted at Yangon, in collaboration with the local hosts Myanmar Egress. The training tool kit for the programme was developed at the Centre for Research in Social Sciences and Education, Jain University.

Dr. Sandeep Shastri, Pro Vice Chancellor, Jain University and Director CERSSE, was the Chief Training Consultant who conducted the workshop with other experts from the Forum. The trainers who went through the intensive training programme will now roll out the Capacity Building Workshops in the country. The five day Training of Trainers (TOT) workshop was preceded by a 3 day workshop conducted by the International Resource Persons team headed by Dr. Sandeep Shastri. This was the seventh in a series of workshops conducted in Myanmar in the last two years. This workshop was attended by the trainees who were part of the TOT Programme and the observation of the workshop was part of the training process.
