

Promotion of Intellectual Capital by Jain University

The World Intellectual Property Day 2013 was celebrated on 26 April 2013 by the Jain University through a function in which prizes were given away to faculty and students for the most meritorious ideas proposed in response to IDEA CONTEST conducted by the Jain University. The awardees included Mr Nagendra K, Mr Mohan Krishna S, Mr Raghu N of the Electrical and Electronics Engineering Department who proposed a novel scheme for using output of solar pump system; Dr. Gopalakrishna K, Professor, Centre for Emerging Technologies who proposed an idea for hand operated cooling device for lap top; Mr Shashank Jain, Ms Priyansi Lukkad, students of engineering at the School of Engineering and Technology of the University who gave ideas on energy harnessing from noise and Ms Rubini Aishu , also a student of engineering who floated an idea on hand recognition gesture.

In cognisance of the theme “Creativity – The Next Generation” which is the Current Year’s theme for the World intellectual Property Day, Jain University took initiative to hold an Idea contest for its students and teachers in which a score of Ideas were proposed and were judged. The function was presided by the Vice Chancellor Dr.N. Sundararajan, and was addressed by Prof N G R Iyengar, the Director of IIAEM, Prof K R Sridhara Murthy, Prof S.
