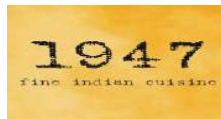

- Full paper must contain these things in this order.

  2. Author's name
  3. Designation

  5. Contact information(Address, E-mail, Ph. No)
  6. Abstract (150-200 words)
  7. Key-words
  8. Main body of the paper
  9. Reference(Name of the Book, Author's name, Name and place of Publication)
