Department of Learning Resource Centre is at the center of academic life and provides a range of services to support enhanced student learning at the campus. A team of subject specialist librarians and other trained staff provides a wide range of services to support information needs and help to make the most of the resources available. It has 1,19,138 books, 12931 e-Books, 8754 CDs, 80,951 e-Journals, 278 Periodicals, 95 Newspapers, 8 Databases, 800 NPTEL lecture Videos, 3525 Bound volumes and 6552 Dissertations/ Project Reports till date. At Knowledge campus, it has about 18565 books, 94 Journals, 19 Newspapers, 22720 Online Journals and a database. The state of the art library stretching 9,200 sq. feet, has the capacity to accommodate about 200 users at a time. All the library services have been automated to be accessible through OPAC. Publishing the papers in peer-reviewed and internationally indexed journals is increasingly important, which will increase researchers' index, wide acceptance and academic profiling. This is also very important for the ranking of the institutions.

Professor Pit. Pichappan, Ph.D is working as the Senior Scientist and Director at the Digital Information Research Labs., Chennai, India and Ilford, UK. He is the Guest Professor at Zhejiang University, China. He is nominated as the *most eminent national expert* to the World Summit Award, Geneva. He was elected to New York Academy of Sciences, Invited to the American Academy of Sciences, and Fellow at the European Centre for Nuclear Physics (CERN, Geneva) 2003. He is the nominee to the Strategy Council of the Global Alliance Panel of the UN ICT Task Force. He had 10 funded research projects. He has published over 100 research papers in several international journals and is the Editor for Journal of Digital Information Management, International Journal of Web Applications; International Journal of Bio inspired Computing and NDT (Springer), ICDIM (IEEE), INTECH (IEEE), FGCT (IEEE), ICADIWT (IOS), RTIS (Springer) Conference Proceedings. He is the reviewer for Information Systems Frontiers, IEEE Journals and Journal of the American Society for Information Science and Technology, Neurocomputing, International Journal of Simulation, Systems, Science & Technology, Data and Knowledge Engineering, Evolving Systems, IEEE Transactions on Data and Knowledge Engineering, International Journal of Computing and Digital Systems, Intl Journal of Internet Technology and Secured Transactions, and Future Generation Communication Systems.



Dr. M. Krishnamurthy is an Associate Professor at Documentation Research and Training Centre (DRTC), Indian Statistical Institute (ISI), Bangalore and Research Guide at Bharathiar University, Coimbatore. He was Professor at Mangalore University, before taking this assignment he served as librarian of Indian statistical Institute Bangalore centre, and University Librarian, University of Mysore. He did his Master degree in Economics and Master of Library Science from Bangalore University in 1987 and 1989 respectively. He has 18 years' experience as Librarian. He is the recipient of the prestigious *Fulbright Fellowship* in 2006 and visited Graduate School of Library and Information Science, Illinois (USA), to carry out research in the field of digital library for one year. He is also recipient of the 2007 *Open Repository Scholarship* to attend Sydney, Australia conference. He has guided 6 Ph. D students in various universities and has contributed extensively to national, international journals and conferences (130 articles). He received the *Bharath Shiksha Ratna* award in 2012 and ILA CD Sharma Best paper award in 2013. His research interests are in the uses of emerging information and communications technologies (ICTs) to enhance libraries and education. His research and teaching interests are in the areas of Social Networking, Digital Archives, Digital Libraries, and Educational Technology.
